## from the Board Chair and Executive Director

Dear Friends of Canopy,

We've reached a milestone this year: our Healthy Trees, Healthy Kids! initiative was successfully completed with 1,070 new trees planted in schools and parks across the cities of East Palo Alto, Menlo Park and Palo Alto. This is Canopy's third significant planting initiative, bringing a total of over 3,700 new trees to our neighborhoods since 2006.

In addition to planting new school trees, we fulfilled other equally important goals. We cared for and maintained thousands of growing trees, empowering kids and community members as active environmental stewards. We advocated for urban trees at city and state levels, making Palo Alto a national example of effective community tree care. We also invested in organizational capacity, completing a new strategic plan and exploring ways to provide more trees to new communities and additional schools.

One planting at a time, we're working toward our vision: a day when every San Francisco Mid-Peninsula resident can step outside and walk, play, and in all ways thrive under the shade of a healthy tree.

Trees can disappear quickly. Canopy's advocacy efforts encourage local and state governments to preserve trees, to include climate-appropriate trees in new developments and to provide the care that will enable city trees to thrive.

Together with city governments, residents, school communities and supporters like you, we continue our ambitious programs to bring the life-giving benefits of trees where they're most needed across the Mid-Peninsula.

## Growing a vibrant urban forest

We are not only planting trees; we are transforming communities by growing an urban forest that provides life-giving benefits. Our approach is multifaceted: by connecting and engaging institutions, communities and individuals we build human networks that support urban trees. In 2014, we:

- Planted 385 trees, completing our Healthy Trees, Healthy Kids! initiative and exceeding our 5-year goal of 1,000 new trees in total.
- Transformed barren schoolyards in East Palo Alto for 1,400 students.
- Engaged over 2,500 students in the care of urban trees.
- Ensured the health of 2,000 newly planted trees through regular maintenance and monitoring.

## Multiplying impact through community engagement

Our approach to tree planting and care relies on community engagement. In 2014, more than 1,000 volunteers contributed over 5,000 hours to help us accomplish our goals. The benefits of this approach are numerous.

- Engaging students, families, and neighbors allows us to accomplish more. We also invite residents to connect, learn, and join us in our mission.
- Empowering local tree stewards at every planting site and ensuring our volunteers are well trained helps us achieve rates of tree survival and longevity that are among the highest in the nation.
- Educating residents about the benefits of trees while advocating with local government and institutions strengthens community support for protecting and enhancing the urban forest.

## Fostering a new generation of nature stewards

School trees provide rich opportunities for students to explore and learn about urban nature that surrounds them. This year, Canopy successfully piloted hands-on, grade-specific lessons for 27 classrooms in the Ravenswood City and Palo Alto Unified School Districts. The lessons provide students with powerful learning experiences that engage their minds, bodies, and senses, igniting curiosity about the natural world. Canopy also engaged 6 high school students this year through service learning internships, providing stipends, job training, and leadership experience. The youth provide regular tree care—weeding, mulching and pruning—helping young trees thrive. In the process, they make connections between trees, nature, and their own communities, and learn the importance of caring for the urban environment.

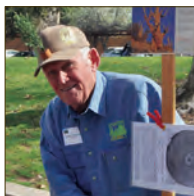

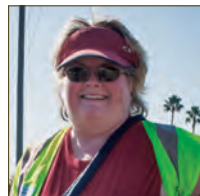

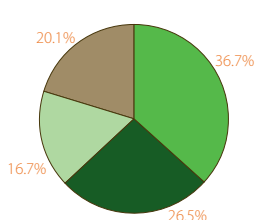


## Fiscal Year 2014 Financial Summary \*

Total operating revenues reached \$560,410 while operating expenses were \$557,317.

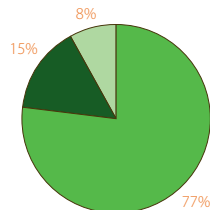
