Canopy is seeking an Urban Forestry Intern for the fall. The Urban Forestry Intern will work closely with the Tree Care and Youth Programs Coordinator and Teen Urban Foresters, local high school youth employed by Canopy to care for the young trees we have planted. The intern will gain leadership and work experience, make a positive impact in the community and the environment, work with local youth, and gain knowledge about trees.

- Pay: \$17/hour
- Responsibilities include: Planting Trees and Caring for trees by pruning, watering, weeding, mulching, and adjusting stakes, leading Teen Urban Foresters and volunteers, and helping at events
- Training topics include: Tree pruning, tree care, tree identification
